Dear Parents/Guardians,

Episcopal Day School utilizes Google Apps for Education for students, teachers, and staff. As with any education endeavor, a strong partnership with families is essential to a successful experience. We would like to share with you information regarding the use of Google Apps for Education at EDS and are requesting your parental permission for your student to use Google Apps.

The following services are available to each student and hosted by Google As part of Episcopal Day School's online presence in Google Apps for Education:

- Docs – a word processing, spreadsheet, drawing, and presentation toolset that is very similar to Microsoft Office
- Calendar – an individual calendar providing the ability to organize schedules, daily activities and assignments
- Sites – an individual and collaborative website creation tool
- Mail – an individual **internal** email account for school use managed, monitored, and filtered by EDS.

Using these tools, students collaboratively create, edit and share files and websites for school related projects and communicate via email with Episcopal Day School students and faculty. These services are entirely online and available 24/7 from any Internet-connected computer.

Google Apps for Education is governed by federal laws and local policies to include:

- Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)
COPPA applies to commercial companies and limits their ability to collect personal information from children under 13. By default, advertising is turned off for Episcopal Day School's presence in Google Apps for Education. No personal student information is collected by Google for commercial purposes. This permission form allows the school to act as an agent for parents in the collection of information within the school context. The school's use of student information is solely for education purposes. Student information that is "collected" by Google is described as projects, documents, emails, files, username and password.

- Student Acceptably Use Policy
This governs student use of technology/networked resources at EDS and signed by both student and parent at the beginning of the school year. It is expected that students will operate within the parameters of the

Student Acceptable Use Policy with regards to Google Apps for Education. If this policy is not signed by both student and parent, your student will not have a Google account or access to any of its associated resources.
