- Evaluate student growth and progress
- Implement clear and consistent classroom management strategies focused on student social-emotional needs

- Actively support the mission and strategic plan of the school
- Communicate and partner effectively with students, families, teachers, and other professionals on a regular basis
- Meet with families on scheduled conference days and more frequently if necessary
