Summer Reading

We are excited about our summer reading program for rising Kindergarten and Fourth-grade students! All families were given a color-coded Reading Tracker for this assignment at our lower school conference at the beginning of May. **Students will track their reading throughout the summer and return the colored Reading Tracker on the first day back to school in August.** All grade levels have at least one assigned book to read. In addition, **third and fourth graders** have an **assignment packet** to complete that supports their required reading. The required reading for each grade level will be the first text for the initial assignments during the first week of school.
