

All-School Welcome Day Schedule of Events for Families
Tuesday, August 15, 2023

Upon arrival, please proceed to the Welcome Center at the school's front entrance. Our enthusiastic staff will greet you and provide your welcome packet containing important information, such as your event name tags, carpool numbers, school calendar, and other items you and your family will need before the **first day of school on Wednesday, August 16.**

PLEASE NOTE: *Preschool families* may bring their child's supplies to the classroom on All-School Welcome Day to minimize disruption on the first day of school. **Lower and Middle School students should bring school supplies to campus on Wednesday, August 16th.**

Preschool, Nature School, and Lower School Schedule

Please follow the schedule below to pick up your welcome packet before proceeding to your child's classroom. Once students have met their teacher, they will be taken to the playground for supervised activities while parents remain for a brief presentation by the classroom teacher.

FAQs

What can I expect?

During the parent program on Welcome Day, each teacher will provide an information sheet that will give you an overview of the class, including information about communication, curriculum, expectations, and an overview of their classroom. We hope that this initial meeting opens communication and fosters a spirit of positive collaboration and community.

What do I do if I have children with teacher presentations occurring at the same or overlapping times or cannot attend the event? We have done our best to stagger our programming so families can attend their children's presentations. We will have a record of everyone who does not attend and will have your packets available in the front office on the first day of school. In addition, your child's teacher and division head will be more than happy to answer your questions. We will ensure you have the information you need for a successful start to the school year.

What do I do with my older child while I am in the session with my younger child?

Older siblings should report to the gym until it is time for their class program. Following each session, parents may pick up an older sibling in the gym and drop off a younger sibling. We will have activities in the gym for the children to enjoy if their parents are attending sessions for siblings. Each child will be able to meet their teacher at the beginning of their assigned time and be well cared for while parents attend sibling sessions or visit the information fair in the library.

When should my child bring their school supplies to school?

Preschool families may bring their child's supplies to the classroom on All School Welcome Day to minimize disruption on the first day of school. **Lower and Middle school students** should wait to bring school supplies or locker items to school on Wednesday, August 16th. Middle school advisors will work with students on binder and locker setup and organization during the first weeks of school.
